Token: A Journal of English Linguistics is an **open-access** academic journal which publishes original, previously unpublished research articles and book reviews focusing specifically on English linguistics. It accepts both synchronic and diachronic work, favoring empirical, corpus-based research. The journal also considers the publication of special issues on specific topics.

The journal is listed in **Sherpa Romeo**, **EBSCO** (Academic Search Ultimate), the European Reference Index for the Humanities and the Social Sciences (**ERIH PLUS**), the Directory of Open Access Journals (**DOAJ**), and the **MLA** Directory of Periodicals.

Moreover, it is also indexed in **SCOPUS**: the review by the Scopus Content Selection & Advisory Board included the following evaluative comments about *Token*:

Token features in the Norwegian Register for Scientific Journals, Series and Publishers and is also listed among A-class (i.e., top rank) scientific journals by **ANVUR**, the Italian Ministerial Agency for the Assessment of Research and University Teaching and Management.

Submissions are welcome throughout the year. Contributors wishing to offer special issues or special sections within issues should contact the Editors outlining the topic(s) they wish to address and providing a preliminary table of contents (with the names and affiliations of the prospective contributors).

All submissions are double-blind peer-reviewed by experts in the relevant areas, provided that the manuscripts are deemed of sufficient quality and relevance by the Editors-in-Chief or guest editors where applicable. There are no article processing charges, but all submitted manuscripts must be prepared according to the style sheet available at token.ujk.edu.pl/submit and sent to token.journal@gmail.com as anonymized Word documents. Finalized versions are expected to be camera-ready. Under normal circumstances, Jan Kochanowski University Press publishes Token once a year, generally by mid-December.
